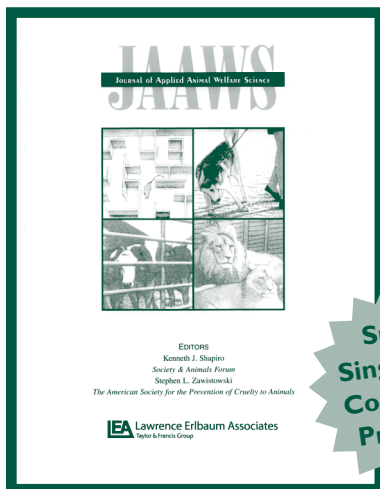

Symposium Papers from Caring During Crisis: Animal Welfare During Pandemics and Natural Disasters

Lawrence Erlbaum Associates is proud to announce a special issue of the *Journal of Applied Animal Welfare Science*. The issue, edited by Dr. Suzanne Millman, will feature papers presented during the symposium *Caring During Crisis: Animal Welfare During Pandemics and Natural Disasters*, held April 29 – May 1, 2007 at the University of Guelph, Guelph, Ontario, Canada.

In the wake of recent natural disasters, such as Hurricane Katrina, and concerns about pandemics, such as Avian Influenza, many communities are evaluating their plans for emergency response. Accounts by people who were reluctant to leave their pets behind during evacuation orders and images of mass killing of farm animals during depopulation protocols illustrate the need for thoughtful attention to animals during times of crisis.

The symposium is hosted by the Colonel K.L. Campbell Centre for the Study of Animal Welfare at the University of Guelph. Its objectives are (1) to raise awareness about how animals, and the people who care for them, are affected during pandemics and natural disasters, and (2) to share knowledge about how animal welfare may be addressed during these situations.
