

Teaching Hospital Oncology Service

Oncological cases are an integral part of the Teaching Hospital caseload. Animals diagnosed with cancer through the OVCTH's other services or referred by their regular veterinarian are placed under the care of the Oncology Service. The Oncology Service consists of a board certified internist, a radiologist, an intern, a radiation therapist and two registered veterinary technicians devoted exclusively to oncology. Patients may be hospitalized for the purpose of receiving chemotherapy or radiation therapy, although most of our patients are treated on an out-patient basis. Current research areas include gene therapy and canine leukemia immunophenotyping. Consultation for practitioners is available from this Service.
