



## Changing your career path?

We welcome applications from individuals who have worked or studied in other fields and want to become a veterinarian.

Candidates who hold a bachelor's degree but are missing some of the prerequisite courses may return to university (full-time, or part-time only upon prior approval) to take the prerequisites for the Doctor of Veterinary Medicine program at the University of Guelph. These courses must be assessed by the University of Guelph Admissions Office to ensure that they have the necessary content and that they are being taken at the maximum appropriate year level.

Applicants with a university degree and family or work commitments may present their case by letter to the OVC Admissions Committee, requesting the option of completing their academic requirements on a part-time basis.
