- 3 referee assessments (2 veterinarians with whom you have worked and 1 professional) submitted online by the referees directly to the university
- Official transcripts from all post-secondary institutions attended – University of Guelph transcripts are automatically transferred



You will be assigned a University of Guelph email account with which you can access your WebAdvisor account for updates on your application status.

Should you be selected for an interview, you will be contacted by email in April regarding an interview in May. Interviews are conducted in person in the MacKinnon building and are in the Multiple Mini Interview format.
