



ON CAMPUS & OFF CAMPUS ACCESS TO RESEARCHLINK

On Campus

In order to access ResearchLink, you must be connected to the campus network. While you are on campus using a hard wired computer (connected to the internet with a blue cable) you should be able to use your Single Sign On credentials to connect to [ResearchLink](#).

If you are using wireless connectivity, ResearchLink can be accessed as long as you are using the University of Guelph **secure** wireless connection.

Off Campus

Once you are off campus, you will not be able to login to ResearchLink without establishing a secure connection to the campus network. Whether you are at home, or at the local coffee shop, it is important to ensure that your connection is secure, and you can do so by establishing a [Virtual Private Network or VPN](#).

Please contact the IT help person for your department and ask the person to download the appropriate VPN software if you do not already have this on your computer. Computing and Communication Services (CCS) has provided [instructions for using the WebVPN client](#) for those wishing to attempt it themselves.
