

Overview of Scholarship available to International Graduate Students

International Entrance Scholarships

- Ontario Trillium Scholarships (Doctoral)
- Nora Cebotarev Memorial Graduate Scholarship (Master's and Doctoral) (see below)
- Ellen Nilsen Memorial Graduate Scholarship (Master's and Doctoral). (see below)
Both Cebotarev and Nilsen selected on the basis of academic achievement, combined with a demonstrated commitment to social change.

- Ontario Trillium Scholarships (Doctoral)
 - o The Ontario Trillium Scholarship (OTS) program is a provincially-funded initiative to attract the best qualified international students to Ontario for PhD studies. 4 OTS are awarded annually at the University of Guelph.
 - o Value and duration: \$40,000 a year up to a total of four years provided the recipient maintains good academic standing and continues to meet recipient eligibility requirements.
 - o Application and Deadline:
Students do not apply. Departments may nominate exceptional candidates to their College Dean's Office by **February 1, 2016**. Nominations that are endorsed by the College Dean's Office will be considered in the university wide competition by the Office of Graduate & Postdoctoral Studies (OGPS) Awards Committee. Nominations from the College Dean's Office are due to OGPS by **February 12, 2016**.

 - o Eligibility to be nominated
Nominees must:
 - Be an international student
 - Be intending to pursue a full-time PhD program at the University of Guelph in the upcoming summer, fall or winter semester
 - Have achieved an A- average in each of the last two years of full-time study
 - Not currently be studying at an Ontario institution
 - Not concurrently hold a scholarship offered by any of the following agencies: Social Sciences and Humanities Research Council (SSHRC), the Natural Sciences and Engineering Research Council (NSERC), the Canadian Institutes of Health Research (CIHR), Ontario Graduate Scholarship (OGS), Queen Elizabeth II Graduate Scholarship in Science and Technology (QEII-GSST).

 - o Eligibility to hold an OTS
To hold an OTS, recipients:

- must maintain an A- average and satisfactory progress towards completion of their degree
- must register and remain registered as a full-time student (a change in status may result in termination of payments and/or returning funds already received)
- transitioning to permanent residency status will continue to be eligible for the balance of their OTS scholarship for a total of four years. Transitioning does not infringe upon OTS funding for recipients as long as permanent residency status is not obtained prior to beginning the OTS award.
